Li Zhengyu, currently serves as a board member of the Chinese Museums Association (CMA), responsible person of the CMA Security Committee, and head of Public Access and Service Management Department at Henan Museum.

He began working in museum security management and research in 1997. Since 2008, he has organized and hosted 15 annual meetings of the Security Committee, as well as 16 training courses that have trained more than 2,000 museum security managers and technicians across China. From 2008 to 2025, he led or participated in compiling and publishing the four-volume Theory and Practice of Museum Security in China, which has been widely adopted by Chinese museums, establishing him as a leading expert in the field.

Li remains focused on the security risks and countermeasures confronting museums worldwide. Through his role as a board member, he hopes to advance resource-sharing and mutual learning, jointly forging a more resilient global museum security ecosystem.
